

Arranging for a Caddie at Red Run

For a member, arranging and taking a caddie for the first time can be intimidating. There is no need for intimidation. The experience that one gets by playing a round of golf with a caddie will create a desire to do it over and over again. Please remember that you are creating a job for a young person every time you take a caddie.

Arranging for a caddie:

- When calling the first tee to make a tee time, let them know that you would like to take a caddie.
- You can request a certain level of caddie.
- If desired, you can request a caddie, but we need to give all of our caddies the opportunity to get experience.
- If you are entertaining guests and would like caddies, please make us aware of your guests' abilities, and we will set up the group with caddies accordingly.
- If you desire to have a caddie for a tournament, please contact the first tee and let them know.

Some members like taking only B Caddies. Others desire Honors. It is up to you to make that decision. Please remember to rate your caddie according to their responsibilities based on the level they are at. Expecting a B Caddie to perform the services of an Honor is not fair. Nor is it fair if an Honor only provides the services of an A Caddie. Please review the section on "What to Expect from My Caddie" for further information on caddie responsibilities.
